Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship Program at Zucker Hillside Hospital, Donald and Barbara Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell, offers positions for a one-year ACGME-accredited fellowship in addiction psychiatry (PGY-5), starting July 1, 2021. The Fellowship provides training in a range of settings, including an inpatient detoxification unit, a consultation liaison service, an outpatient methadone program, and outpatient drug-free and dual diagnosis programs.

Extensive one-to-one supervision is offered throughout the Fellowship. The Program also emphasizes academic activities, including weekly didactics, a journal club, a monthly case conference, and elective research. Fellows are encouraged to attend and present at local and national conferences. Electives are customized according to individual interests and career goals.

The Zucker Hillside Hospital is conveniently located just minutes from NYC via private or public transportation, and a short distance from beaches, wineries, waterfront towns, villages and parks. The regions surrounding the hospital also boast some of nation's top school districts. We offer an exceptional compensation and benefits package.

Candidates must have completed an ACGME-accredited general psychiatry residency training program (or be a PGY-4 psychiatry resident at the time of application) and be either licensed in New York State or eligible for a license (i.e. passing USMLE Step 3). It is encouraged that applicants also get their Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and Drug Addiction Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000) licensure to be able to prescribe buprenorphine.
