## Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship Recruitment Guidelines for the 2022-2023 Class

This document is to communicate recruitment guidelines that 50 of the 54 ACGME Accredited Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship Programs have agreed to abide by for the 2022-2023 class. These guidelines were developed in collaboration with the AAAP Education Committee with the intention of standardizing the fellowship recruitment process in an applicant-centric manner.

## The recruitment guidelines are:

- 1. All fellowship applications for recruitment of the 2022-2023 class will be submitted and reviewed using the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS). There are two exceptions to this rule:
  - A. Internal applicants who are ONLY applying to their home program may apply outside of ERAS.
  - B. After January 1, 2022 programs with unfilled positions may choose to accept applications outside ERAS
- 2. It is anticipated that the majority of applicant interviews will occur between July 22<sup>nd</sup> and September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- Programs agree that they can begin to provide offers to applicants on Monday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 12p EST via email on a rolling admission basis.
- 4. Programs agree to give applicants a **minimum of 72 hours** to consider an offer before the position may be offered to another applicant.
- 5. Programs agree to communicate to applicants that they have interviewed when they have filled all of their positions.
- 6. Expectations of applicants:
  - A. Applicants are expected to provide commitment to accept only one offer.
  - B. Applicants are than expected to notify other programs as soon as possible that they are declining their offers.
- 7. Programs and applicants may discuss their rank list prior to the offer date voluntarily, but applicants and programs may not be compelled to share their rank list.
- 8. Programs and applicants may discuss offers by phone after the initial offer is made by email.
